### **NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF THE BAR SUPERIOR COURT – DISTRICT OF LAVAL CONSOLIDATION OF PROCEEDINGS**

Even when joined under article 210 of the *Code of Civil Procedure*, each joined proceeding remains separate.

Thus, the parties must file a copy of their pleadings in each joined proceeding at the court office. Such pleadings include applications in the course of proceedings and requests for setting down a case for trial, among others.

When required, the parties must pay the fees for legal stamps in each file (i.e., requests for setting down a case for trial in each joined proceeding).

Failing which, the court office will record only the first heading and court number indicated on the pleading in the court ledger, which pleading will then be filed only in that court record. The Court will address only the proceeding in which the pleading was filed.
